Outcomes:

1. Obtaining latest updates and progress reports on the implementation of the project, including identification of positive results and issues that needed to be addressed by the National teams.
2. Improving of financial reporting component through receiving thorough presentation about correct accounting documentation of the implemented activities, identifying current issues regarding communication and feedback channels to ensure efficient communication.

4. Receiving initial draft of Methodology for the Multidisciplinary Trainings and identifying key issues for further clarification to involve latest trends and good practices of project partners.
